Student Visa issued

You should email a copy of your visa to cas@Bolton.ac.uk and book your flights then complete the university questionnaire. The closest airport to Bolton is Manchester International Airport.

Covid Tests

Take a Covid-19 test no more than 72 hours before you travel.
