Student Visa issued

You should email a copy of your visa to cas@Bolton.ac.uk and book your flights then complete the university questionnaire. We would suggest arriving at London Heathrow Airport.



Arrival to England

On arrival you will need to stay in the Managed Quarantine Hotel for 10 days and 11 nights. On completion you will be able to leave and will be offered a transfer back to London Heathrow Airport



Attend the University

You can now attend the University. Don't forget to bring your **passport, visa and qualifications**. You will also need the receipts for the hotel quarantine and flight to Manchester airport.
